The meetings will be conducted by representatives of [International Organization for Migration](#) – the leading intergovernmental organization specialized in migration law.

The programme of the meetings includes:

- Legalization of residence in Poland (visa, permanent residence permit)
- Differences between student visa and a temporary residence permit
- Procedure of application for a residence permit
- Taking up a job during studies
- Legalization of stay after obtaining university diploma
- Polish descent and Card of the Pole holders' rights

The meeting conducted in **English** will be held on **14<sup>th</sup> of October (Friday) at 2.00 p.m.** and the meeting conducted in **Russian** will be held on **19<sup>th</sup> of October (Wednesday) at 2.0 p.m., both in the building of the Old Library in the Main Campus**. The exact place will be sent via email to registered participants.

Each meeting will last approximately one hour.
